Name and location of our think-tank

- INiTiative Réflexion et Action pour le Climat Et le Financement climatique (INTERFACE)
- Located at University Cheikh Anta Diop de Dakar (UCAD), physically based at Ecole Superieure Polytechnique (Shool of engineering) but linked to all University Faculties and institutes



















INTERFACE: vision, mission & strategic objectives



Contribute to long-term low-carbon development and increase the resilience of vulnerable communities and ecosystems to climate change



Increase the flow of climate finance in Senegal and the sub-region by empowering public and private stakeholders

















INTERFACE: vision, mission & strategic objectives

Four (4) strategic objectives

- Set up a digital "network" platform of national experts working on CC in relation to climate finance
- Build the capacity of the network's climate finance experts to support the development of climate projects;
- Provide services and products designed to strengthen the skills of government and non-government actors in mobilizing climate finance;
- Establish a dialogue platform or forum between the various actors involved in climate change management (Science-Politics-Private) on climate finance

















INTERFACE's key priorities?

- Internal (within INTERFACE) capacity building,
- Setting up a database of local and national expertise,
- capacity building for external stakeholders (govt, CSOs, GPF, etc),
- provision of technical services and products related to climate finance.
- Strengthen existing collaborations and identify new opportunities for collaboration at local, national and regional level















How INTERFACE engage the Govt in priority setting?

Organisation of meeting (online & in-person) with stakeholders (local and central govt, sectors, accredited entities, local communities, NGO)

- Identification of there needs in terms of knowledge, capacity strengthening and skills development
- Identification of priory sectors to develop project ideas,
- Identification of there expectations from INTERFACE
- INTERFACE expectations from the stakeholders
